We know these are unprecedented times and we are having to teach and learn in new ways. As an Algebra 2 collaborative team, Mrs. Taylor, Coach Anderson, Coach Russell, and I have come up with a digital learning plan that would best prepare the Algebra 2 students for their next course.

We will continue to use Schoology to deliver daily notes/videos on content and administer weekly assessments, as well as, Delta Math for daily practice. **Please note Schoology is unavailable daily from 7am until 12:30pm.* I will also continue to update my blog (www.mrskovalsky.weebly.com) and send out emails as needed to keep everyone in the loop.

As you know, Allatoona is moving to a 4-day work week beginning Monday, April 13th. To help both parents and students plan for the remainder of the semester, I wanted to share with you our instructional and assessment plans for the course.

- **Monday – Wednesday:** We will cover 2 keepers and expect students to take notes, watch video examples, complete practice problems and Delta Math assignments.
- **Thursday:** Students will take a quick check over that week's material. Students will have a 1-hour time limit and 1 opportunity to complete the assessment. Quick Checks will be due the following Monday.

Students will be given DAILY GRADES for their Delta Math assignments and a QUIZ GRADE for the weekly Quick Checks.
